





PRESS RELEASE

Fly-tipping Action Wales issued the below press release to Wales-wide media on Thursday 16 April – sharing advice and guidance on safe waste storage during the coronavirus pandemic, while warning householders to be vigilant when accepting offers for waste removal services on social media platforms during this time.

Householders in Wales urged to steer clear of illegal rubbish removal operators advertising on social media during Coronavirus Health Crisis

[Fly-tipping Action Wales](#) is urging householders **across Wales** to manage their rubbish responsibly and be vigilant when accepting offers from individuals posing as legitimate waste disposal businesses on social media during the coronavirus lockdown.

Householders are also encouraged to postpone garden and home DIY projects until lockdown restrictions are lifted, unless they are able to safely store excess waste at their property without causing health and safety risks, such as fire hazards.

The stern warning and [key messages](#) from Fly-tipping Action Wales follow concerns from [local authorities](#) over the number of people offering illegal rubbish removal services in community groups such as those found on Facebook, which they fear has increased since social distancing restrictions were enforced in Wales as part of the national fight against coronavirus.

While many people are already minimising their waste production and disposing of it correctly, householders are reminded that they have a legal duty of care to check with [Natural Resources Wales](#) that the person they use to remove rubbish from their home is a registered waste carrier — particularly at this time of national emergency.

In line with health and safety advise issued by [DEFRA](#), all Household Waste Recycling Centres (often referred to as 'local tips') in Wales are closed until further notice.

Therefore, Fly-tipping Action Wales warn that householders are at an increased risk of being scammed by unregistered individuals, who are taking advantage of lockdown restrictions by offering cheap rubbish removal services. These individuals often dump the waste illegally in fields, on roadsides and along country-lanes.

If a waste enforcement officer traces fly-tipped rubbish back to a householder that did not make the appropriate checks for a registered waste carrier, they risk an unlimited fine and prosecution. Local authorities across Wales can also issue the householder with a £300 fixed penalty notice as an alternative to prosecution.

A list of registered waste carriers, which should be used to carry out these vital checks, can be found on the [Natural Resources Wales website](#).

Fly-tipping Action Wales also recommend that people ask where their rubbish is going, request a receipt from the company used to remove the waste and record details of the vehicle involved, including make, model and registration number.

[South Wales Fire and Rescue Service](#), a key partner of Fly-tipping Action Wales, are also concerned over an increased risk of rubbish fires during the coronavirus lockdown, with some householders choosing to burn excess rubbish in their gardens and other individuals deliberately setting fly-tipped rubbish alight.

Whether deliberate or accidental, the Fire Service warn that refuse fires are extremely dangerous, irresponsible and can very quickly spread out of control — causing damage to property, injury and even death.

Fly-tipping Action Wales Programme Manager, Neil Harrison, commented: “*For everyone's health and safety and out of respect for our local authority staff who are working hard to provide communities with vital services, please follow your duty of care and dispose of your waste responsibly.*

If somebody offers you rubbish removal services through social media, you have a legal duty to check that the person or business is a registered waste carrier before using them.

“Fly-tipping is a criminal offence and those committing this crime, particularly during a time of national emergency are placing more pressure on already stretched resources and staff, while putting the waste enforcement officers who investigate and clear up fly-tipped refuse at risk.

“We urge householders to store excess waste at home, or if safe storage isn't possible, we advise postponing DIY projects that are likely to create high volumes of rubbish until lockdown restrictions are lifted and Household Waste Recycling Centres are re-opened.

“We'd also like to remind everyone that leaving unwanted household items and rubbish outside full recycling banks or closed facilities, such as charity shops and local council tips, is still classed as fly-tipping. “Those who choose to fly-tip can face up to a £50,000 fine or twelve months imprisonment if prosecuted at a Magistrate's Court.”

Fly-tipping is a serious crime. It causes considerable damage to the environment, the economy and local communities — with the consequences being up to a £50,000 fine or 12 months imprisonment for the offender.

Mae [Taclo Tipio Cymru](#) yn annog deiliaid tai ledled Cymru i reoli eu sbwriel mewn modd cyfrifol a bod yn wyliadwrus wrth dderbyn cynigion gan unigolion sy'n honni ar y cyfryngau cymdeithasol eu bod yn fusnesau gwaredu gwastraff cyfreithlon yn ystod cyfyngiadau'r coronafeirws.

Hefyd, caiff deiliaid tai eu hannog i ohirio prosiectau garddio a DIY hyd nes y caiff y cyfyngiadau symud eu codi, oni bai y bydd modd iddynt storio'r gwastraff ychwanegol yn eu cartrefi heb arwain at risgau iechyd a diogelwch, fel peryglon Tân.

Mae'r rhybudd llym a'r [negeseuon allweddol](#) gan Taclo Tipio Cymru yn dilyn pryderon ymhlieth awdurdodau lleol ynghylch y nifer o bobl sy'n cynnig gwasanaethau gwaredu sbwriel anghyfreithlon mewn grwpiau cymunedol, fel y rhai sydd ar Facebook – rhywbeth y maent yn ofni ei fod ar gynnydd ers i'r cyfyngiadau o ran cadw pellter cymdeithasol ddod i rym yng Nghymru fel rhan o'r frwydr genedlaethol yn erbyn y coronafeirws.

Er bod nifer o bobl eisoes yn ceisio cynhyrchu cyn lleied o wastraff â phosibl, gan gael gwared ag ef yn y dull priodol, caiff deiliaid tai eu hatgoffa fod ganddynt ddyletswydd gofal gyfreithiol i gadarnhau gyda [Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru](#) fod y sawl a ddefnyddir ganddynt i gael gwared â'r sbwriel o'u cartref yn gludydd gwastraff cofrestredig – yn enwedig ar hyn o bryd, a ninnau yng nghanol argyfwng cenedlaethol.

Yn unol â chyngor iechyd a diogelwch a gyhoeddwyd gan [DEFRA](#), mae'r holl Ganolfannau Ailgylchu Gwastraff Cartrefi yng Nghymru (a gaiff eu galw'n 'ganolfannau ailgylchu/gwastraff lleol' yn aml) wedi cael eu cau hyd nes y clywir yn wahanol.

Felly, mae Taclo Tipio Cymru yn rhybuddio bod deiliaid tai yn fwy tebygol o gael eu twyllo gan unigolion nad ydynt wedi cofrestru, sy'n manteisio ar y cyfngiadau symud trwy gynnig gwasanaethau gwaredu gwastraff rhad. Yn aml, mae'r unigolion hyn yn gollwng y gwastraff yn anghyfreithlon mewn caeau, ar ymylon ffyrdd ac ar hyd lonydd cefn gwlad.

Os yw swyddog gorfodi gwastraff yn llwyddo i olrhain sbwriel a dipwyd yn anghyfreithlon at ddeiliad tŷ a aeth ati i ddefnyddio gwasanaethau rhywun heb wirio ei fod yn gludydd gwastraff cofrestredig, fe allai'r deiliad tŷ hwnnw wynebu dirwy ddiderfyn a chael ei erlyn. Ymhellach, gall awdurdodau lleol ledled Cymru gyflwyno hysbysiad cosb benodedig o £300 i ddeiliad tai, yn hytrach na'u herlyn.

Gellir dod o hyd i restr o gludwyr gwastraff cofrestredig – y dylid ei defnyddio i wneud y gwiriadau hollbwysig hyn – ar wefan [Cyfoeth Naturiol Cymru](#).

Mae Taclo Tipio Cymru hefyd yn argymhell y dylai pobl ofyn i ble y bydd eu sbwriel yn mynd, ynghyd â gofyn am dderbynneb gan y cwmni a ddefnyddiwyd i gael gwaredu â'r gwastraff a chofnodi manylion y cerbyd a ddefnyddiwyd, yn cynnwys ei wneuthuriad, ei fodel a'i rif cofrestru.

Mae [Gwasanaeth Tân ac Achub De Cymru](#), sef un o bartneriaid allweddol Taclo Tipio Cymru, hefyd yn bryderus ynghylch y perygl y bydd mwy o danau sbwriel yn digwydd yn ystod cyfngiadau'r coronafeirws, gyda rhai deiliaid tai yn dewis llosgi eu sbwriel ychwanegol yn eu gerddi ac unigolion eraill yn rhoi sbwriel sydd wedi'i dipio'n anghyfreithlon ar dâr yn fwriadol.

Pa un a gaiff y tanau eu cynnau'n fwriadol ynteu'n ddamweiniol, mae'r Gwasanaethau Tân yn rhybuddio bod tanau sbwriel yn anghyfrifol ac yn beryglus dros ben, a bod modd iddynt losgi allan o reolaeth yn gyflym – gan arwain at ddifrod i adeiladau, at anafiadau, ac at farwolaethau hyd yn oed.

Dyweddodd Neil Harrison, Rheolwr Rhaglen Taclo Tipio Cymru: “*Er lles iechyd a diogelwch pawb, ac er parch i staff ein hawdurdodau lleol sy'n gweithio'n galed i ddarparu gwasanaethau hanfodol i gymunedau, cofiwch gadw at eich dyletswydd gofal a gwaredu eich gwastraff mewn modd cyfrifol.*

“*Os bydd rhywun yn cynnig gwasanaethau gwaredu sbwriel i chi ar y cyfryngau cymdeithasol, mae gennych ddyletswydd gofal gyfreithiol i wirio bod y person neu'r busnes dan sylw yn gludydd gwastraff cofrestredig cyn ei ddefnyddio.*

“*Mae tipio anghyfreithlon yn drosedd, ac mae'r bobl sy'n cyflawni'r drosedd hon – yn enwedig a ninnau yng nghanol argyfwng cenedlaethol – yn rhoi mwy o bwysau ar adnoddau a staff sydd eisoes yn brin, gan roi'r swyddogion gorfodi gwastraff a fydd yn ymchwilio i'r tipio anghyfreithlon, ac yn ei glirio, mewn perygl.*

"Rydym yn annog deiliaid tai i storio unrhyw wastraff ychwanegol yn eu cartrefi; neu os na fydd hyn yn bosibl, rydym yn eu cynghori i ohirio unrhyw brosiectau DIY sy'n debygol o greu llawer o wastraff hyd nes y bydd y cyfngiadau symud wedi cael eu codi a hyd nes y bydd Canolfannau Ailgylchu Gwastraff Cartrefi wedi ailagor.

"Hefyd, hoffem atgoffa pawb fod gadael sbwriel ac eitemau cartref nad oes eu hangen mwyach y tu allan i fanciau ailgylchu neu gyfleusterau sydd ar gau, fel siopau elusen a chanolfannau gwastraff lleol, yn cael ei ystyried yn achos o dipio anghyfreithlon.

"Gall y rhai sy'n dewis tipio'n anghyfreithlon wynebu dirwy o hyd at £50,000 neu ddeuddeg mis o garchar os ydynt yn cael eu herlyn mewn Llys Ynadon."

Mae tipio anghyfreithlon yn drosedd ddifrifol. Mae'n achosi niwed mawr i'r amgylchedd, i'r economi ac i gymunedau lleol – ac fe allai'r sawl sy'n cyflawni'r drosedd hon wynebu dirwy o hyd at £50,000 neu 12 mis o garchar.
